You have recently passed the hunting exam successfully, are a proud owner of an Austrian hunting license, and you now want to take your first steps in hunting! You have correctly identified it as a female, but is it a weak yearling doe that you are allowed to shoot, or is it a leading doe that has recently given birth and clearly shows the "birthing pits"? How can I see the



"spider"? Do I have a proper bullet backstop? How far away is the animal really? These and many other questions can only be answered through experience in practice. Practical experience is simply irreplaceable! For this reason, we have developed **a special young hunter program.** You will be expertly guided from the beginning through all hunting steps such as stalking, identifying, shooting, field dressing, and finally butchering the game. Experience some carefree, exciting, and above all educational hunting days **in an Austrian hunting ground.** 



## New Hunter - The First Steps in Hunting...

### The Hunting Ground:

The hunting area is located in northern Lower Austria. The landscape has barely changed in the last hundred years and offers habitat for not only roe deer and wild boar, but also some red and fallow deer, as well as rare species like the Eurasian eagle-owl, the European otter, and even the lynx. The wolf has been a regular "guest" since 2018! The hunting ground covers an area of about 5000 hectares, with roughly half forest and half agricultural land. The hunting lodge, situated in the hunting area, has been lovingly renovated. It offers three



double rooms and three single rooms with all modern comforts. A cozy kitchen, a spacious entrance hall, and a large living room are also part of the house.

#### The Costs:

3 travel days (e.g., from Friday noon to Sunday noon) with 2 overnight stays and 4 stalking sessions, including accommodation with breakfast and dinner at the hunting lodge, stalking guidance and expert 1:1 support, all hunting-related transfers, trophy prepreparation, the harvested game will be jointly butchered and vacuum-sealed ready for the kitchen, and **can be taken (1 piece) for free**, Lower Austrian guest hunting license (if necessary), FAIR HUNT processing fee.
