Hunting Area:

The approximately 10,000-hectare high mountain hunting area is located in the Hohe Tauern in the state of Salzburg. For many years, this area has been managed with exemplary sustainable natural use. An extremely efficient and intelligent hunting concept ensures an excellent population of red deer, roe deer, chamois, and mouflon, as well as strong trophy holders. Hunting takes place from 700 to 3500 meters above sea level. It must be clearly stated that this is an extremely steep terrain, scarcely developed by roads, and hunting here requires good physical condition and mountain experience! However, if one meets these requirements and is willing to exert effort during the hunt, one is sure to be rewarded with a successful hunt in a stunningly beautiful mountain region.

Overnight stays are in simply equipped hunting lodges. Accommodation is generally limited to 2 hunting guests and 1 stalking guide. The individual stalking expeditions are conducted from the hunting lodge with the guide.




