The Hunting Areas:

There are three contiguous areas with a total of approximately 15,000 hectares. These are classic roe deer and small game hunting areas located in Eastern Hungary around the town of Gyula. The roe bucks have an average antler weight of 350-450 grams, and every year some bucks around 500 grams are also taken.

Brush hunts are organized for groups of 6-8 hunters targeting pheasants and hares. Hunters with their own dogs are welcome. Per day, a hunter can expect a pheasant bag of 5-10 birds. Accommodation is provided in a cozy small castle located outside the village. From there, hunters are picked up by the stalking guide for the hunt.









Brush hunt in Hungary....

The Basic Costs: 3 travel days with 2 overnight stays in the castle in a double room with breakfast and dinner, 2 days participation fee for brush hunting, Hungarian hunting license, and processing fee: per hunter € 445.- (dog in accommodation € 15,-/day; additional brush hunting day with accommodation and half board € 120,-)

Shooting Fees for Small Game:

Pheasant: € 26,-Hare: € 60,-

Possible Hunting Dates:

Last week of October to December - by arrangement





Payment Procedure: Upon booking, a deposit of € 300,- per hunter is required. The final settlement will be handled through Fair Hunt according to the hunting protocol.
