## GUT KLEPELSHAGEN

Living and working with nature – this is the philosophy of Gut Klepelshagen, the showcase of the **German Wildlife Foundation**. Located in southeastern Mecklenburg-Vorpommern, agriculture, forestry, and hunting operations merge economic goals with the needs of wildlife. For red deer, this means large areas of peace and long closed seasons on one hand, and high hunting quotas on the other.

Hunting plays a significant role in the approximately 2,300-hectare private hunting district of Gut Klepelshagen. Roe deer, wild boar, and red deer are hunted to reduce populations and process venison into high-quality food products. The foundation consistently implements its hunting policy demands at Gut Klepelshagen: shorter hunting periods, a night hunting ban, and hunting rest zones. Sustainable hunting does not contradict nature and species conservation.

Gut Klepelshagen forms a private hunting district and belongs to the “Rothemühl” management community, which is responsible for red and fallow deer, wild boar, and roe deer over an area of about 25,000 hectares. Hunting in Klepelshagen is carried out efficiently, with minimal disturbance and in a targeted manner. In the Valley of the Deer, the agriculturally used core area of the estate, which is horseshoe-shaped surrounded by forest, there is year-round hunting peace on around 300 hectares of open land. All game animals have quickly realized that they can feel safe here. Through individual hunting, mainly in the surrounding open land, multiple joint sittings, and a few driven hunts with around 20 shooters, about 50 red deer, 120 roe deer, and between 100 and 150 wild boars are taken annually. Like the farm animals, the game is also processed in the Gourmet Manufaktur Gut Klepelshagen.

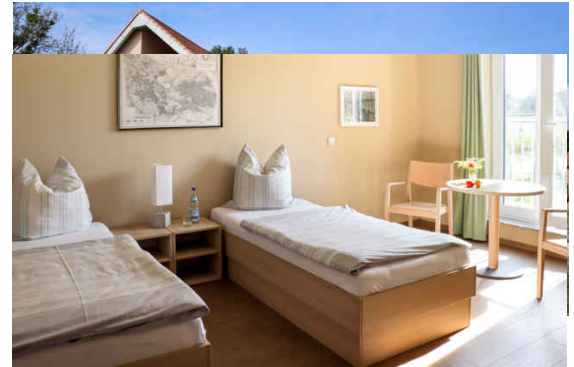
## The Costs:

Participation in the hunt from Thursday to Sunday Per hunter: € 600,-

Includes: All shooting of red deer females (adult females, yearlings, calves) and red deer spikes, piglets and yearlings, young roe deer, fawns and yearlings, predators.

## Additional shooting of trophy animals:

Red deer stag (2 – 4 j.)	€ 400,-
Wild boar male from 2 years	€ 700,-
Adult Roe deer till 200g	€ 125,-
Adult Roe deer till 275g	€ 200,-
Adult Roe deer till 350g	€1,-/g



**Not Included:** Travel, accommodation, and catering (optional at Haus Wildtierland – prices upon request), and the German hunting license.

**Cancellation Fees:** Up to 4 weeks before the hunt: € 200,- per hunter; less than 4 weeks before the hunt: € 250,- per hunter.

**Regulations:** Hunting license will be checked at the beginning. Unauthorized game will be charged at double the rate according to the current rate catalog. Closed season violations require self-reporting. Injured game that does not come to the bag will be charged at € 50,-. Improperly handled game will be charged at € 25,- per animal.
