

Boar Hunting in the Carpathians

In the Eastern Carpathians, in the counties of Harghita, Sibiu, and Mures, most hunting areas for these boar stand hunts are located. It is a fantastic area for wild boar, bear, and wolf. Currently, bears and wolves are restricted from driven hunts. Licenses are presently available only for bears or wolves that have caused damage. The boars in the Carpathians grow very large – often over 200 kg when gutted, with tusk lengths ranging from 20 to 27 cm!

The best hunting season is from November to February. Target airports are Sibiu or Cluj, or one can travel by bus. Hunters are accommodated in cozy country inns within the hunting areas.

Travel and Hunting Costs: 3 travel days with 2 days of accommodation with full board, 2 hunting days (4 stalks), 1:1 stalking guide, Romanian hunting card, and all transfers during the hunt, € 775,- per hunter (additional hunting day, all transfers, with accommodation and full board: € 325,-)

Not included: Travel by plane or car (flights to Tirgu Mures or Cluj) Transfer airport - hunting area round trip per person: € 200 Trophy preparation and evaluation: € 25,-/boar Rental rifle including ammunition: € 50,-/day

Hunting Season - Boar: 1 January to 31 December

Trophy fee boar:

Payment Process: Upon booking, a deposit of € 300,- per hunter must be paid. The final billing is done on-site after the hunt.
