

Chamois Hunting in the Fagaras Mountains

Chamois Hunting in Romania

Our partner hunts in the Southern Carpathians, in the world-famous Fagaras Mountains. A vast mountain range with some high alpine areas. Chamois hunting is a day hunt and one should bring both physical fitness and some mountain experience. These are the essential components of a successful chamois hunt.

The chamois population, which was heavily hunted after the political change, has recovered over the past ten years and chamois with 100 to 105 CIC points are absolutely realistic. With a bit of luck, even stronger chamois can be taken. The best time for chamois hunting is the period of October/November.

The starting point for the hunt is the city of Sibiu. Accommodation is in the hunting area, in a very good hotel.

Recommended Hunting Dates: 15 October – 15 November – by arrangement







Chamois Hunting in the Fagaras Mountains....

Travel and Hunting Costs:

3 travel days with 2 days of accommodation with full board, 2 hunting days (4 stalks), 1:1 stalking guide, Romanian hunting card, and all transfers during the hunt, € 925,- per hunter (additional hunting day, all transfers, with accommodation and full board: € 400,-)

Hunting Season - Chamois: 10 September to 15 December

Trophy fee Chamois:

Abnormal Chamois \in 1 500,-Wounded \in 1 500,-Missed \in 125,-



Not included:

Travel by car or plane (flights to Tirgu Mures or Cluj)
Transfer airport - hunting area round trip per person: € 200

Trophy preparation and evaluation: € 100,-/chamois Trophy transport to home country: € 50,-/chamois Rental rifle including ammunition: € 50,-/day

Payment Process: Upon booking, a deposit of € 300,- per hunter must be paid. The final billing is done onsite after the hunt
