

This offer is like no other Asian hunting trip; it's about Tajikistan, its people, and its wildlife!

Fair Hunt supports the Tajik wildlife management model, which includes the longstanding commercial outfitting industry and the community-based hunting program. The two wildlife management programs complement each other, as shown by the promising results in the conservation of mountain ungulates. Fair Hunt has supported the Tajik conservation program for a decade and collaborates with eight major hunting areas. The main goal is to support sustainable wildlife management in Tajikistan. We offer sustainable and fair hunting with local communities in the remote mountain regions of Tajikistan. Join the most experienced traditional local hunters, who share their centuries-old knowledge of survival and hunting in these challenging regions.

Fair Hunt works directly with the local hunting grounds and guides in each protected area. We cut out the middlemen and can save you thousands of Euros on these hunts!







Our program includes many of the most famous wildlife species of Central Asia:

Pamir Ibex, Bukhara Ibex, Bukhara Urial, Tajik Markhor, Marco Polo Sheep, Wolf, and Wild Boar in special partnerships with Tajik hunting grounds.

Ibex

Individual species or combination hunts are possible for all species, noting that area changes and additional hunting fees may be required for combination hunts.

These ibex hunts can take place in one of our areas. Family and friends are warmly welcome for an additional fee. These concessions are long-term, and part of the organizer's profits supports the local population and their communities, as well as the protection and management of wildlife in the mountains of Tajikistan.

We also coordinate the logistics by obtaining the necessary permits and accompanying the client from their arrival in Tajikistan to their departure home. We also support the transportation of trophies. The ibex are at least 8 years old, with horn lengths over 105 cm (41.5 inches). Often, horn lengths exceeding 115 cm are achieved. The success rate is 90% and also depends on the hunter's physical condition.

These are fair hunts where success is not always guaranteed. The terrain is often steep, with elevations up to 14,000 feet, requiring a lot of hiking. When possible, horses, yaks, and 4x4 jeeps are also used. To support your success, we recommend doing a lot of physical training and practicing long-distance shooting. If all this appeals to you, get ready for the hunt of a lifetime!

Hunt Schedule: The best hunting time is from September 15 to February 28, with the rut occurring from mid-December to early January.

DETAILS AND RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THE HUNT:

ACCOMMODATION/MEALS

In all cases, you will stay in heated huts, yurts, or safari tents provided by the host village or in spike camps of the local guides. Depending on the situation, a Jeep and horse/yak will be used. The interpreter will pick up the hunter at the airport in Dushanbe and accompany them on the trip.

SAMPLE SCHEDULE

Day 1-2: Departure from home to Dushanbe, transfer to the hunting area immediately upon arrival, acclimatization and setting up the camp.

Day 3-8: Dedicated to hunting.

Day 9-10: Transfer back to Dushanbe and flight home.









CONDITIONS/POLICIES

Deposit: 20% of the trip price.

Full payment is made after returning to the home country.

No refund of the deposit in case of cancellation. However, a replacement hunter can be appointed.

In case of cancellation within 30 days before the hunt, the full trip price will be charged. We recommend purchasing trip cancellation insurance.

If we are unable to conduct the hunt, we will refund the payment or apply it to a future hunt.

Wounded game is determined by the presence of a blood trail or an obvious physical injury to the animal after the shot. The guides will do everything to recover the wounded/dead animal during or after the hunt. If an animal is not found, it is considered harvested, and a trophy fee is due. However, the hunter can repeat the hunt for free in the coming season (either extend the number of days or return later, until the end of February).
